- Imported goods and or resold goods
- Weapons
- Live animals
- Culturally inappropriate items
- Offensive, counterfeit or unauthorised products
- Items that The Arts Village may consider unsuitable for the market

Ready-to-eat artisan foods (high quality, distinctive product in small quantities, usually made by hand and using traditional methods) and locally grown/made artisan goods such as jams and sweets (operating under applicable health laws) will be permitted on a case-by case basis and will be allocated sites together in one area. Takeaway/coffee/hot food stalls are charged at a different rate to account for provision of bins etc.

You will need to be registered with your local authority (eg. Council) and you will need to have a mobile/market stall licence with Rotorua Lakes Council. Proof of registration and licence will need to be provided to The Arts Village prior to the event. For more information please see:

Setting Up and Packing Down

- Stalls may be set up from 9am on the day and stallholders must be on site by 9.30am. Stalls must be ready to sell from 10am.
- Stalls may not be packed down any earlier than the market closing time of 3pm, if you have sold out of your product, please put up a 'sold out' sign.

If you have trouble locating your space on market day, look for one of our Arts Village team (wearing high-vis) who can assist you.

Koha/Payment

In Te Ao Maori, Koha is a form of payment, contribution or donation. Your koha is greatly appreciated and helps to bring such events to our community.

Cancellations:

We are weather dependent as this is an outdoor market. Our team will do their best to ensure the market can go ahead on the date we advertise.
